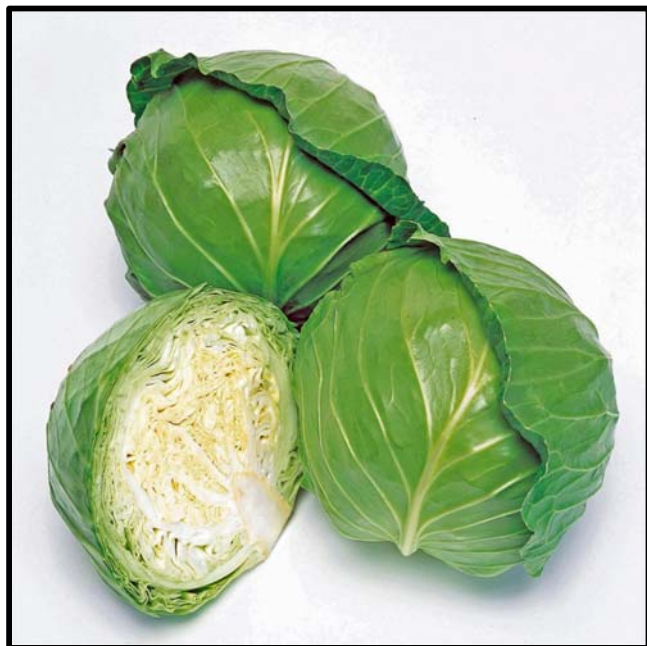


Hybrid Cabbage Expresso



DESCRIPTION: Early maturity, bright green, large, ball-shaped head with a short core.

MATURITY: Early, approximately 60 to 65 days from transplant

COMPARABLE VARIETIES: Grenadier

VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS: Expresso is very uniform and has good size potential. This variety is slow to burst and exhibits resistance to Downey Mildew and intermediate resistance Fusarium Yellows. Mild flavor.

ADAPTABILITY: Coastal California
