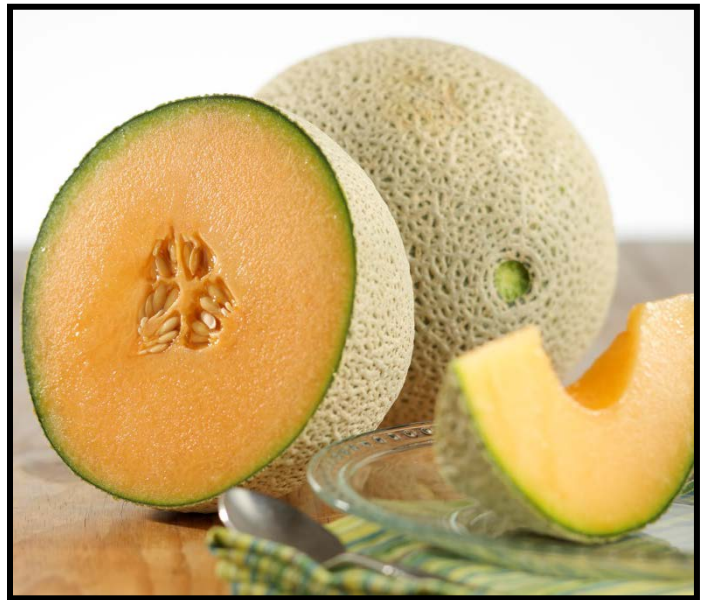




Hybrid Cantaloupe (Western Shipper Type) Melon Trinity



DESCRIPTION: Early-late season (San Joaquin Valley) and mid-season (Arizona) cantaloupe melon. Round with a small seed cavity and brilliantly orange-colored flesh.

MATURITY: Early through late season depending on growing area

COMPARABLE VARIETIES: El Camino, Gold Rush

CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS: Trinity exhibits an extremely small cavity in conjunction with a tight, slightly raised net and sizing between 6 and 12. A strong, vigorous vine along with resistance to Powdery mildew 1, 2 and Fusarium race 0 & 2 give this variety great protection from many elements. Requires less nitrogen and irrigation inputs than most other varieties.

MARKETS: Fresh and process

- Deep orange interior
- Strong vine
