

# Hybrid Honeydew Melon Buena Vista (RH1012)



<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	Orange flesh Honeydew melon for seasonal melon production territories in North America. Fruit size class 5, 6. Firmness 5 - 6 psi, Brix 14 – 16%. External bright white skin, salmon-orange flesh complemented with nice tight cavity.
<b>MATURITY:</b>	California 60 - 90 days, southwest US desert 80 - 95 days, México and Central America 60 – 70 days.
<b>COMPARABLE VARIETIES:</b>	Uncle Sam, Honey Gold
<b>CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS:</b>	Buena Vista will express less sugar net. Fruit size class 5 & 6, nice round fruit with good field holding capability. Intermediate resistance to Powdery mildew.

<b>ADAPTABILITY:</b>	San Joaquín Valley, SW Desert, Central América, México.
