Matthiola incana



SIZE/PLANT HABIT: Height: 30 - 36" / Columnar / Annual
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Early blooming, dense flower spikes, averages 90% double-flowering types
MARKET USE: Cut flower

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

SEASONAL APPLICATION:

SOWING: Summer, fall, winter

FINISHING: Fall, winter, spring (cool areas)

PHOTOPERIODISM Slight daylength sensitivity

PLUG STAGE:

TRAY SIZE: 288, 128 cell

GERMINATION: Emergence 7 - 14 days / 70°F / lightly cover with vermiculite

SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING: Plug stage only — late fall to early spring only

PLUG FINISH: 3 -4 weeks

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 20 – 25 days after sowing (3 to 4 true leaves)

SPACING: 5" x 5" (20 cm) greenhouse; 5" field

DAYS TO FLOWER AFTER

SOWING: 75– 105 days

TEMPERATURE: 45- 65°F

EC: Keep EC level under 0.3

PH: 5.5 – 6.5

COMMON DISEASE/PEST: Rhizoctonia, Phytophthora, Xanthomonas/Aphids, thrips, leaf rollers

NOTES:

- If it is too cold during the seedling stage the plants will be short
