DESCRIPTION:	Early, long day, yellow Spanish type
MATURITY:	Early maturing (105-110 days)
COMPARABLE VARIETIES:	Tamara, Sabroso
VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS:	This early, long-day onion is comparable to Tamara and Sabroso. Milestone matures earlier than both these onions. Bulbs are globe-shaped with a high percentage of single centers, and have excellent skin quality and retention. The outstanding features of this variety are its earliness, storability and skin color. With thinner necks, this hard, yellow Spanish-type onion cures down quickly compared to other varieties in this class. Milestone is well suited for both domestic and export markets.
