<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	Long day Northern storage type
<b>MATURITY:</b>	Early
<b>COMPARABLE VARIETIES:</b>	Arsenal, Ricochet, Corona, Mountaineer
<b>VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS:</b>	This early Northeastern type has early-to mid-season maturity, being slightly earlier than Mountaineer. Bulbs are tight and firm with a globe shape, good size with thin necks. It has strong resistance to botrytis and is slow to bolt. Excellent for storage, under optimum conditions Trailblazer can store until June.
