COLORS AVAILABLE: Coral Nymph (FS Quality Mark), Lady in Red (AAS, FS Gold Medal), Forest Fire, Snow Nymph, Mixture

SIZE/PLANT HABIT: Height: 14 - 24" / Half-hardy annual, USDA Zone 4

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Extremely long bloom time on early, well branched, and compact plants. High heat tolerance.

MARKET USE: Mixed container, pot, garden

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE

SOWING: 512 to 288 plug

FINISH CONTAINER: Pack, quart, gallon

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION: Emergence 10 - 15 / 68 - 72°F

PLUG FINISH: 4 – 5 weeks

FINISHING:

DAYS TO FLOWER AFTER SOWING: 10– 11 weeks

TEMPERATURE: 64- 85°F

GARDEN:

This series attracts hummingbirds and other pollinators

NOTES:

- B-9 applications (1250 – 2500 ppm) in the plug stage improve branching and reduce internode stretching after transplant.
 - 1st application 2-3 weeks after sow, a second can be applied 1-2 weeks after transplanting in very hot conditions
- Time to flower depends on temperature
