

Juncus filiformis Spiralis™



SIZE/PLANT HABIT/TYPE: Hardy perennial, to USDA zone 5 - 10
Height: 8 inches

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS:: Glossy, dark green linear leaves are spiraled and twisted, forms a tight mound resembling corkscrews, margin aquatic plant

MARKET USE: Container, landscape, water feature

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:

SOWING: 288- 128 tray

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION 73 - 75°F

PLUG FINISH TIME: 7 – 9 weeks

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 7 – 9 weeks after sowing

WEEKS TO FINISH: 16 – 20 weeks from sowing

TEMPERATURE: 70 – 73°F

EC: 1.0 – 1.2 mS/cm (pour thru method)

PH: 5.8 – 6.3

NOTES:

- Maintain appropriate EC levels, keep moist and warm for quickest finish results
- Seedlings are slow growing at first, but will speed up once potted forming good plants in 4 to 5 months
