Highlander (T-803)

DESCRIPTION: Extra early, long day, Northeastern type

MATURITY: Early maturing (85-90 days)

COMPARABLE VARIETIES: Norstar class, but earlier

CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS: This early Northeastern type is new and has shown high pack outs and earliness. Highlander’s extra-early maturity makes it ideal for many northern, long-day areas. Bulbs are globe shaped and generally larger in size when compared to Norstar. Highlander is good for transplant as well as direct seeding. It has resistance to botrytis and Downy mildew. Highlander makes size while maintaining an excellent shape. Best results under irrigation.
