COLORS:	Light Yellow, Pink, Orange, Red, Rose, Scarlet, White, Yellow, Mix, Tropical Blend
FLOWER/GARDEN SIZE:	Height: 10 - 12 inches / 4" spectacular dahlia-form double flowers
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS:	Early flowering, large, double flowers
MARKET USE:	Packs, 4 to 6" pots, mixed containers

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS

PLUG STAGE

SOWING: 288 tray

GERMINATION: 4 - 8 days / 68 - 72°F, cover seed

EC (POUR THROUGH METHOD): Emergence to cotyledon expansion = 0.5 - 0.75 mS/cm
Cotyledon expansion to plug finish = 0.5 - 0.75 mS/cm

PLUG FINISH: 4 - 5 weeks in 288 tray

FINISHING

TRANSPLANT: 25 to 30 days after sowing

DAYS TO FLOWER: 55 - 65 days

TEMPERATURE: 65 - 80°F day / 60 = 65°F night

EC (POUR THROUGH METHOD): 1.0 - 1.5 mS/cm

pH: 5.8 - 6.2

COMMON DISEASES/PESTS: Alternaria leaf spot, botrytis, bacterial leaf spot, powdery mildew/Aphids, thrips, whitefly

GROWTH REGULATORS: Plants will stretch under low light, B-Nine can be used to control stretch

NOTES:

- Plants require good air circulation
- Southern states can grow Zinnia for year-round sales
